

LADDER INSPECTION AND CARE

STOP ACCIDENTS BEFORE THEY HAPPEN BY INSPECTING YOUR LADDER BEFORE EACH USE.

Inspect ladders for damage before each use. If any part of the ladder is missing, damaged, or broken, immediately remove it from service and clearly label it as out of order.

Store ladders in a dry place – avoid exposure to heat or moisture. Rest ladders on support racks during storage. Clean off any grease, mud, oil, or other debris prior to use. Tie down ladders securely during transportation to avoid damage.
